- Increase and sustain core funding for Queensland specialist sexual assault services to ensure that all survivors, regardless of location, have timely access to specialist support and care.
- Expand safe, affordable, and culturally appropriate housing options for women, young women, and older women, who are survivors of sexual violence, including trauma-informed crisis, medium and long-term solutions.
- Support and fund First Nations-led responses to sexual and domestic violence, prioritising community-driven approaches that reflect cultural knowledge and selfdetermination.
- Provide resources for diverse communities to design and implement tailored responses to sexual and domestic violence, ensuring marginalised voices are represented and heard.
- Fund and support comprehensive prevention programs, including mandated relationships and sexuality education in schools, focusing on consent, respect, and healthy relationships.
- Adopt a whole-of-government approach to "Start by Believing"—ensuring that all sectors, from police to health services, respond to survivors with belief, empathy, and timely support.
